3d List: Non-commissioned officers above Grade 11. (Paragraph 9, Army Regulations), arranged according to grade.

4d List: Enlisted men below Grade 11. (Paragraph 9, Army Regulations), arranged according to the word formation of the Company, that is, by squads. These names should be numbered consecutively beginning with No. 1.
