 Separate lists of FIVE COPIES EACH, will be filled out by each company or detachment commander as follows:  
 (a) List: Officers arranged according to rank; (b) List: (if any) civilian employees, if any. These names should be numbered consecutively beginning with No. 1.  
 (c) List: Non-commissioned officers above Grade 17; (Paragraph 9, Army Regulations), arranged according to grade.  
 (d) List: Enlisted men below Grade 15; (Paragraph 9, Army Regulations), arranged according to the usual formation of the Company, that is, by ranks. These names should be numbered consecutively beginning with No. 1.
