Separate lists of FIVE COPIES EACH, will be filled out by each company or detachment command number as follows:

1st List: Officers arranged according to rank or grade, if any; civilian employees, if any. These names should be numbered consecutively beginning with No. 1.

2d List: Non-commissioned officers above Grade 17, if Paragraph 3, Army Regulations, arranged according to grade.

3d List: Enlisted men below Grade 16, if Paragraph 3, Army Regulations, arranged according to the usual formation of the Company, that is, by squads. These names should be numbered consecutively beginning with No. 1.

To be filled in by Organization: Give full name of organization including company and regimental designations.

To be filled in by Quartermaster, Port of Embarkation: Name of Transport or Embarkation Steamer.
