2d List: Non-commissioned officers above Grade 17, (Paragraph 6, Army Regulations), arranged according to grade.

3d List: Enlisted men below Grade 16, (Paragraph 6, Army Regulations), arranged according to the usual designation of the Company, that is, by squads. These names should be numbered consecutively beginning with No. 1.
