INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING OUT THIS FORM

1. All U. S. Military Personnel, including civilian employees of the Army, returning to the United States, will be listed on this form, which will be completed in twelve copies by Personnel Adjutant of Port of Embarkation.

2. The personnel will be classified and grouped under the following headings, with reference to the reasons for their return:

(1) "Back and Wounded," (2) "Prisoners," (3) "On Leave," (4) "On Discharge," (5) "On Duty," (6) "For Retirement," (7) "For Officers," (8) "Discharged."

3. Each group will be arranged according to rank and grade from A. S. to W. Army Field Grade and Field Grade O. S. C. to be inserted between officers and enlisted men.

4. The names will be numbered consecutively within each group, beginning with No. 1.
