

**PASSENGER LIST OF ORGANIZATIONS AND CASUALS  
RETURNING TO THE UNITED STATES**

**INSTRUCTIONS:**  
 Separate TWELVE COPIES EACH will be furnished to each command or detachment commander as follows:  
 1st Class: Officers received according to Rank, Name, Army Field Clerk, Field Clerk U. S. C., Civilian Employees, and to be returned to the command beginning with No. 1.  
 2nd Class: Noncommissioned Officers down to and including Color Sergeant (See A. R. P. 1).  
 3rd Class: All railroad men below Color Sergeant (A. R. P. 1), increased according to usual direction of the Command, that is, BY SQUADS.  
 This form shall be used for CASUAL, unless otherwise indicated in the annex, but within each class all entries will be sub-graded under the following headings with reference to the reason for their return, and each sub-grade being listed on the same sheet: (1) Deceased, (2) Sick and Wounded (3) Prisoners, (4) For Duty, (5) On Leave or Furlough, (6) Miscellaneous. The word "Casuals" and the names of the group will be entered in the space provided for name of organization, and the Rehabilitation Personnel Adjutant will sign his name in the space provided for the signature of organization commander.

To be filled in by command or detachment commander: Name of vessel, Date of sailing, Port of arrival, Date of arrival.

To be filled in by Rehabilitation Personnel Adjutant, U. S. A.: Name and Serial Number, Rank and Army Field Clerk, Expedition, Date of sailing, Date of arrival, Address.
