**INSTRUCTIONS**

1st Class: Officers assigned according to rank, branch, Army Field Clerk, Field Clerk, Q. M. C., Civilian Employees. **None** (Indicate correct rate booklet with No. 1.)

2nd Class: Non-commissioned Officers down to and including Color Sergeant (See A. R. Par. 5.)

3rd Class: All other men below Color Sergeant (A. R. Par. 5.) except according to special orders of the Commanding Officer, and to BY ORDER.

The men who need to be CASUAL military personnel will be accompanied in the manner, but unless each man of course will be sub-grouped under the following heading with reference to the reason for their return, no more than one man with same name listed on the same sheet: (1) Discharged; (2) Sick and Wounded; (3) Prisoner; (4) For Duty; (5) On Leave or Pass; (6) By Discharge. The word "Casual" and the reason of the group will be entered in the space provided in the name of organization, and the Enlistment Number (MOS) will be entered in the space provided for the signature of organization commander.
