**INSTRUCTIONS**

Separate list of TWELVE COPIES EACH will be furnished to each company or detachment commander as follows:  
 1st Class: Officers assigned according to Rank, Name, Army Field Order, Field Order G. M. C., Officer Employment - Name to be furnished separately according to No. 1.  
 2nd Class: The commanding Officers down to and including Color Sergeant (See A. R. P. No. 5).  
 3rd Class: All enlisted men below Color Sergeant (A. R. P. No. 5), arranged according to usual formation of the Company, that is BY SQUADS.

This form when used to list CASUAL military organizations will be accompanied in the column for units each other all reports will be sub-grouped under the following headings with reference to the column for their names, but none that are not being listed in the same column: (1) Detachment, (2) Troop and (3) Squadron. (4) For Duty, (5) On Leave or Furlough, (6) Miscellaneous. The word "Casual" and the name of the group will be entered in the space provided for name of organization, and the Enlistment Personnel Address will also be used in the space provided for the address of organization commander.
