INSTRUCTIONS

 1st Class: Officers arranged according to Rank, Station, Army Field Clubs, Field Clubs O. M. E., Civilian Employees. Names to be considered names-
 2nd Class: Noncommissioned Officers down to and including Color Sergeant (See A. R. P. 5).
 3rd Class: All soldiers see below Color Sergeant (A. R. P. 5), arranged according to usual formation of the Company, (See U. S. BY SQUARE).
 This form when used for CASUAL military personnel will be completed in the manner, but within each class all names will be set forward under the following headings with reference to the reason for their return, set here that one such set being filed on the rear sheet: (1) Discharged; (2) Sick and Wounded; (3) Prisoners; (4) For Duty; (5) On Leave or Furlough; (6) Miscellaneous.
