

PASSENGER LIST OF ORGANIZATIONS AND CASUALS RETURNING TO THE UNITED STATES

INSTRUCTIONS

Duplicate list of TWELVE COPIES EACH will be accomplished by each company or detachment commander as follows:

1st Copy: Officers arranged according to Rank, Name, Army Field Order, Field Order (U. S. E. Civilian Function). Names to be transferred correctly to be transmitted with No. 1.

2nd Copy: Noncommissioned Officers down to and including Color Sergeant (U. S. E. Par. 9).

3rd Copy: All enlisted men below Color Sergeant (U. S. E. Par. 9), arranged according to usual formation of the Company, that is, BY SQUADS.

This form is used in the CASUAL, military messages will be accomplished in this manner, but within each class all names will be sub-grouped under the following headings with reference to the reason for their return, not more than one sub-group being listed on the same sheet: (1) Discharged, (2) Sick and Wounded (3) Prisoner, (4) For Duty, (5) On Leave or Furlough, (6) Miscellaneous. The word "Casuals" and the names of the group will be entered in the space provided for name of organization, and the Transportation Personnel Director will sign his name in the space provided for the signature of organization commander.

To be filed in by company or detachment commander: Name of company or detachment commander, Name of vessel, Organization including company and regimental designation, Rank, Name, Army Field Order, Field Order, Date of arrival, Port of arrival, Date of departure, To be filed in by Detachment Personnel Director, U. S. A.

To be filled in by Detachment Personnel Director: Name of vessel, Rank, Name, Army Field Order, Field Order, Date of arrival, Port of arrival, Date of departure, To be filed in by Detachment Personnel Director, U. S. A.
