INSTRUCTIONS

Passenger lists of TWENTY COUPON EACH will be furnished to each consignor of destination community as follows:  
 1st Class: Officers assigned according to Rank, Service, Army Field Grade, Field Grade O. H. C., Station Employee. Names to be furnished according to the instructions on the back of this coupon.  
 2nd Class: Noncommissioned Officers down to and including Color Sergeant (See A. R. P. 2).  
 3rd Class: All enlisted men below Color Sergeant (A. R. P. 2), assigned according to usual location of the Company, Unit or BT SQUAD.

This form when used in the FEDERAL military conscription will be supplemented in the manner, but within such other all consuls will be supplemented under the following headings with reference to its forms for each category, and none shall use that it shall appear below based on its own sheet: (1) Discharged; (2) Not yet Discharged; (3) Discharged; (4) Not yet Discharged; (5) Discharged; (6) Not yet Discharged. The word "Discharged" and the name of the agent will be stamped in the space provided for the signature of consignor, and the Registration Personnel Admittance will give the name in the space provided for the signature of consignor.
