Dear Mr. Timmons:

Hyman Chargo, who was committed to your institution on April 11, 1930 and who was discharged on parole on December 12, 1930, has again appeared in Federal Court and entered a plea of guilty to a violation of the Internal Revenue Laws. He claims that he is or was tubercular and that while in your institution he was confined in the hospital for a period of 5 months. We have reports from two local doctors who have treated him over a period of years; one contends that incarceration might effect a chest condition and the other doctor, the Tuberculosis specialist, claims that he has never been able to find that subject was affected with Pulmonary Tuberculosis and that there is nothing in his present condition which would be aggravated by commitment to a jail or penal institution.

We would appreciate having whatever information your medical staff was able to obtain at the time he was confined at Leavenworth.

An early reply will be greatly appreciated.
