

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

I, MOLLIE GARFINKEL do make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament :- _____

FIRST. I direct that my just debts and funeral expenses be discharged as soon as may be after my decease, provided that my funeral expenses shall amount to only Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.) which said amount shall be given to CHARLES GARFINKEL, my son, to expend for this purpose. _____

SECOND. I hereby give and bequeath unto my son, CHARLES GARFINKEL the whole of Endowment due at my death from Sons of Benjamin Lodge.

THIRD. I hereby give and bequeath to my daughter, YETTA LARGEMAN the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.) .

FOURTH. I give and bequeath to my two grandchildren namely ; CATHARINE AND ELIZABETH LARGEMAN each the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.) .

Fifth. I give and bequeath to my remaining six (6) children, namely ; CHARLES GARFINKEL, WILLIAM GARFINKEL, SOPHIA GOLDENBERG, ROSE MANDEL, MAY RICE, and REBECCA FLO-MENHOFT the fund remaining after payment of my funeral expenses, and payment of legacies above mentioned to be divided between them share and share alike.

LASTLY. I do make and constitute and appoint HERMAN BALABAM, JACOB GOODMAN and CHARLES GARFINKEL to be the executors of this my Last Will and Testament.

Letters Testamentary
